## **CALL FOR INSTRUCTOR – INTERMEDIATE SCREENWRITING**

The Film and Video Arts Society of Alberta (FAVA) is accepting applications for Class Instructor for the upcoming Intermediate Screenwriting class.

This 10 week workshop-style class is for participants with some experience/familiarity with dramatic screenwriting requires them to submit a sample of their writing (completed screenplay or several sample scenes) for submission. The instructor will be determining admission into this class based on those samples. Instructor will lead weekly workshops centered around the reviewing, editing, critiquing, and finalizing of the participants' screenplays.

Instructor must be available to teach or facilitate all classes, provide all handouts, and facilitate the completion of participants' screenplays. Please note that this workshop is planned for in-person instruction but could change to online delivery to comply with COVID-19 policies and Alberta Health Services guidelines. Remuneration is \$40 per teaching hour (30 teaching hours) and \$40 per prep hour (30 prep hours), for a total of \$2,400.

### Qualifications:

- post-secondary education in creative writing, theatre, or equivalent experience
- proven experience as a playwright or screenwriter. Work that has been mounted/produced is preferred
- strong organizational skills; ability to prepare course outline, plan activities to meet learning objectives and stay on schedule
- teaching experience
- experience with online teaching would be an asset
